

THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA—WATER ACT
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Raymond and Stewart Pakka of R. R. #1, Sorrento, B. C. VOE 2W0

are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The source of the water-supply is White Lake.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 28th May, 1980.
- (d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is domestic.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 500 gallons a day, and such additional quantity as the Engineer may from time to time determine should be allowed for losses.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of Legal Subdivision 5 of Section 14, Township 22, Range 10, West of the 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division of Yale District, lying east of Plan H 11659.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are diversion structure, pump and pipe, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been commenced and shall be completed and the water beneficially used on or before the 31st day of December, 1986.
- (j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.

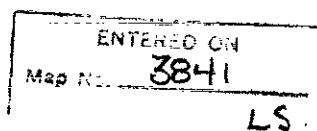

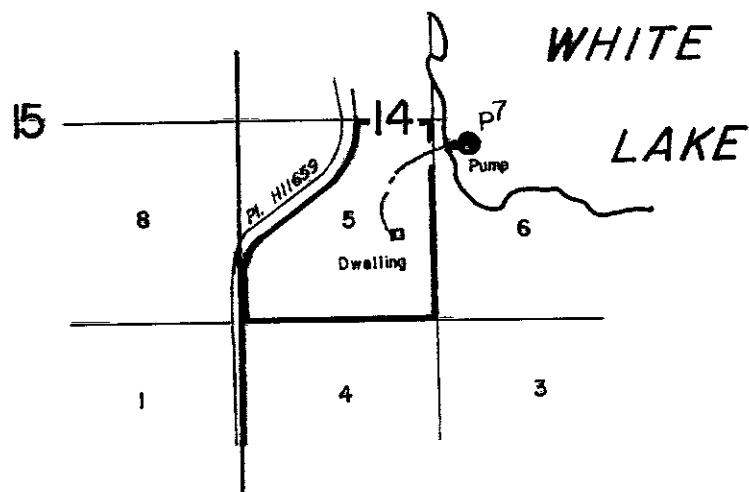
