

THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA—WATER ACT
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Club Creek.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 11th February, 1991.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is conservation (rearing channel).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 0.25 cubic feet per second.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st May to 31st October.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the fractional Southwest 1/4 of Section 15, Township 1A, Range 5, Coast District, except Plan 8967.
- (h) The works authorized are diversion structure, gate valve, weirs, pipeline, rearing channel and settling pond, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The rights granted under this licence are subject to a water reserve established by Order in Council No. 372 dated 16th April, 1928.
- (j) Upon cessation of fish rearing and immediately after fish have been released from the facility, the rearing channel and settling pond shall be completely vacuumed. The effluent vacuum water shall be disposed of in a manner that prevents its re-entry back into Club Creek.

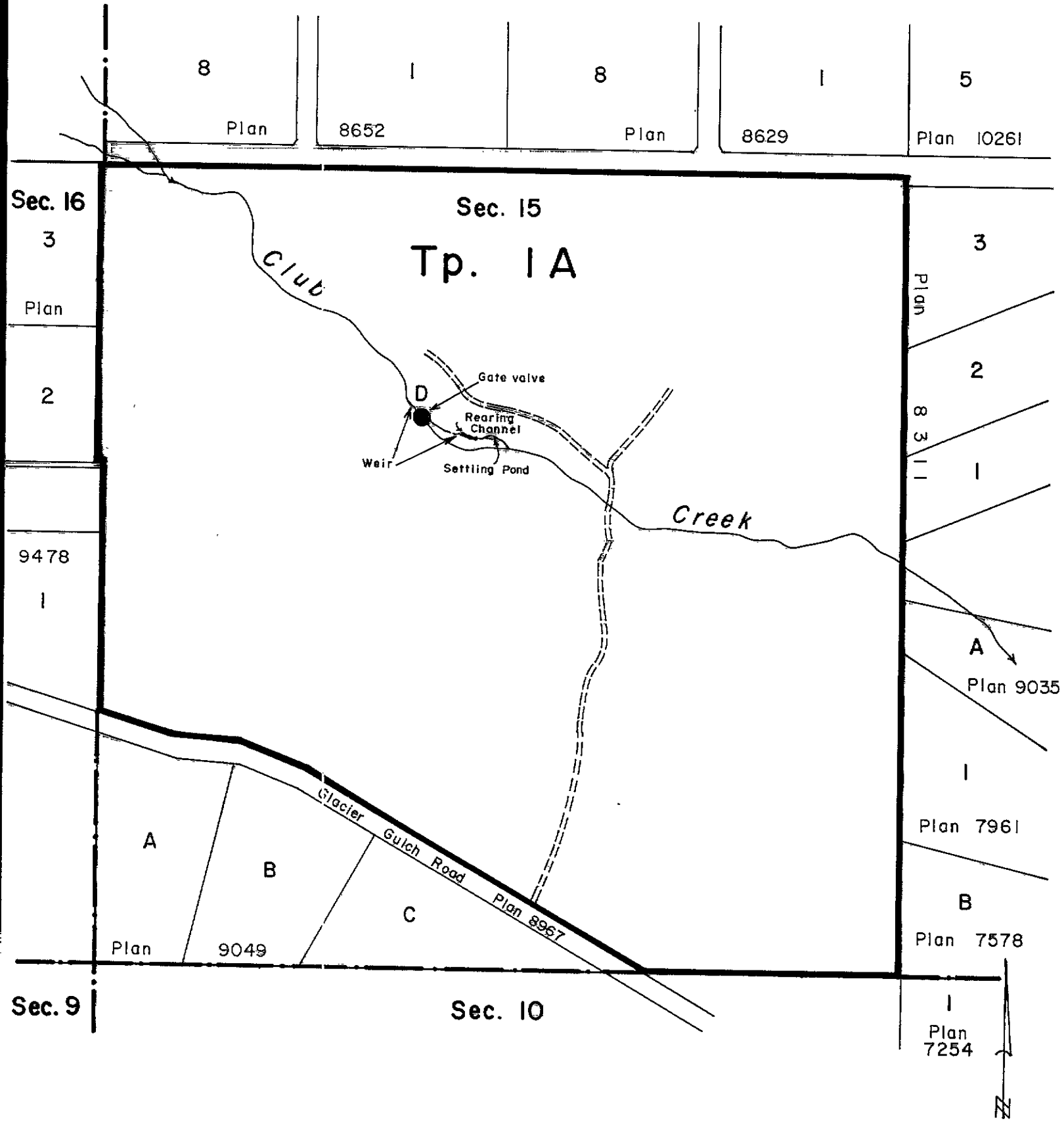
- (k) No chemicals of any kind shall be introduced into the rearing channel or waters of Club Creek.
- (l) The diversion of water authorized under this licence shall be restricted to a maximum of 50% of the flow in Club Creek at all times to a maximum of 0.25 cubic feet per second, and may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing by an Engineer under the Water Act.
- (m) The licensee shall undertake a monitoring programme to determine the effects of the use of water and the discharge on the environment. This programme will be undertaken subject to consultation with the Environmental Protection Program. The programme shall be approved by the Regional Water Manager with details of the programme specified in a separate letter. The programme may be modified by the Regional Water Manager in the future depending upon the monitoring results.
- (n) This licence is issued for an initial term of three (3) years. Upon application, this licence may be extended for additional terms for diversion of specified quantities of water by the Regional Water Manger or the Comptroller of Water Rights, subject to satisfactory water quality and quantity in Club Creek downstream from the settling pond authorized under this licence. Unless extended, this licence shall expire on the 31st day of December, 1996.
