WATER ACT - Section 15

In the matter of **Conditional Water Licence 101428**, which authorizes the diversion of water from **Barnett Spring** for domestic, storage and industrial (stockwatering) purposes.

Having determined that the name of the licensee and Crown Lease date was incorrect and the that there is a new owner, and being satisfied that no persons rights will be injuriously affected, I hereby amend Clause (l) of said licence to read as follows:

Raymond Brookes of Box 88, Taylor, B.C. V0C 2K0 is hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- (l) This licence will expire on the same date as Crown Lease No# 802736 which expires on April 25, 1998. Upon application, this licence may be extended for additional terms for diversion of specified quantities of water by the Regional Water Manager or the Comptroller of Water Rights.

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

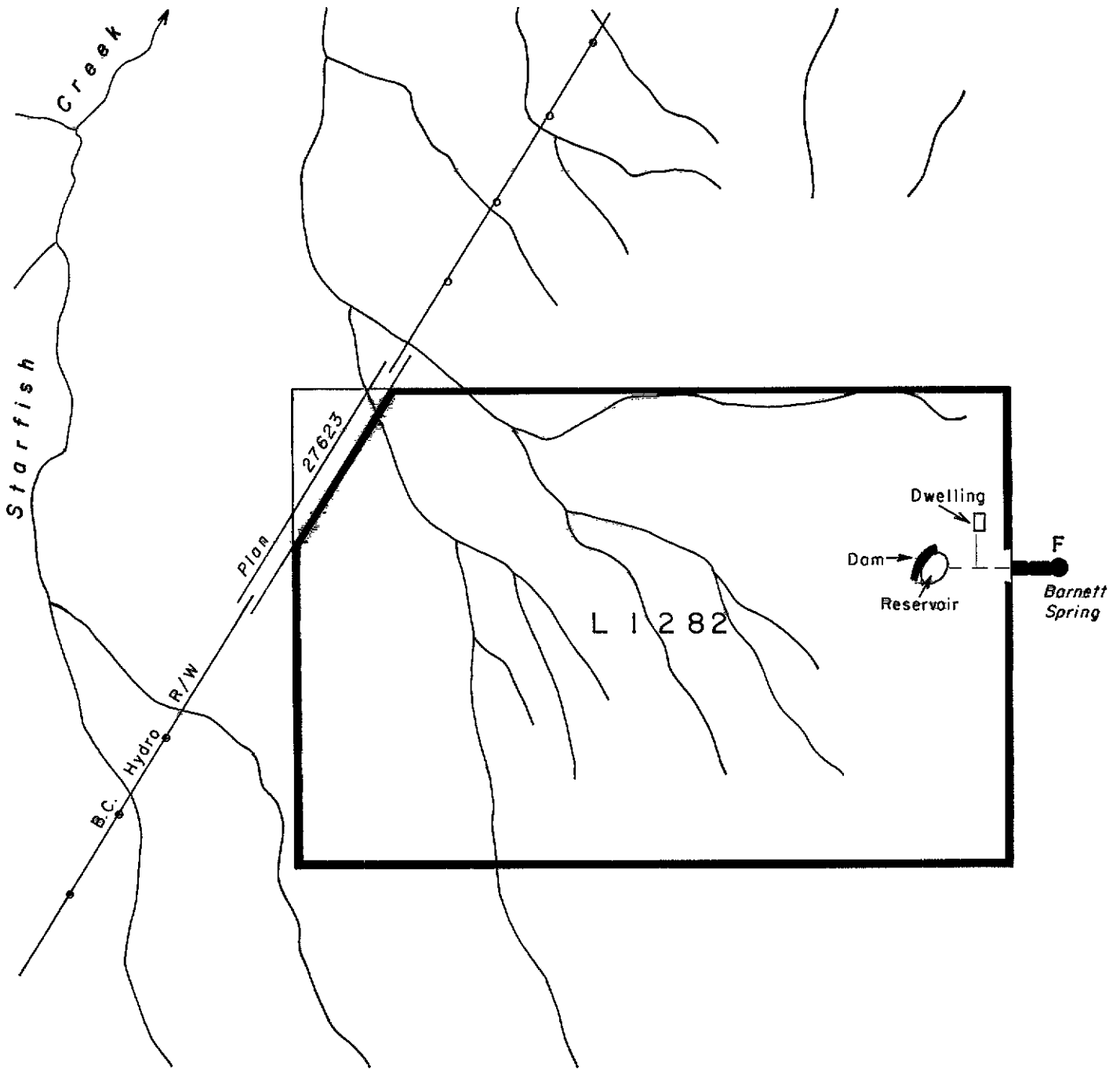
Edward Eugene BARNETT and Raymond Loeffler BROOKS of P.O. Box 88, Taylor, British Columbia, V0C 2K0, are hereby authorized to divert, store, and use water as follows:

- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Barnett Spring and the reservoir is Barnett Pond.
- (b) The storage site and the point of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 14th June, 1990.
- (d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic, storage and industrial (stockwatering).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 500 gallons per day and for industrial (stockwatering) purpose is 500 gallons per day, the maximum quantity which may be diverted to fill the reservoir is 2.5 acre feet per annum.
- (f) Water may be used throughout the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of District Lot 1282 lying East of Plan 27623, Peace River District.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are a diversion structure, pipe, dam, and reservoir, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make a regular beneficial use of water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the Engineer under the Water Act and any changes to said works must be approved by the Engineer prior to reconstruction.
- (k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (l) This licence will expire on the same date as Crown Lease No. 802736 expires, April 25, 2008. Upon application, this licence may be extended for additional terms for diversion of specified quantities of water by the Regional Water Manager or the Comptroller of Water Rights.
