## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE



- The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially (i) used. The licensee shall continue to make a regular beneficial use of water in the manner authorized herein.
- The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the Engineer under the Water Act and any changes to said works must be approved by the Engineer prior to reconstruction.
- This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located (k) approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- This licence will expire on the same date as Crown Lease No. 802736 expires, April 25, (1) 2008. Upon application, this licence may be extended for additional terms for diversion of specified quantities of water by the Regional Water Manager or the Comptroller of Water Rights.
