


THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA—WATER ACT
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of the lease to which this licence is appurtenant to is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

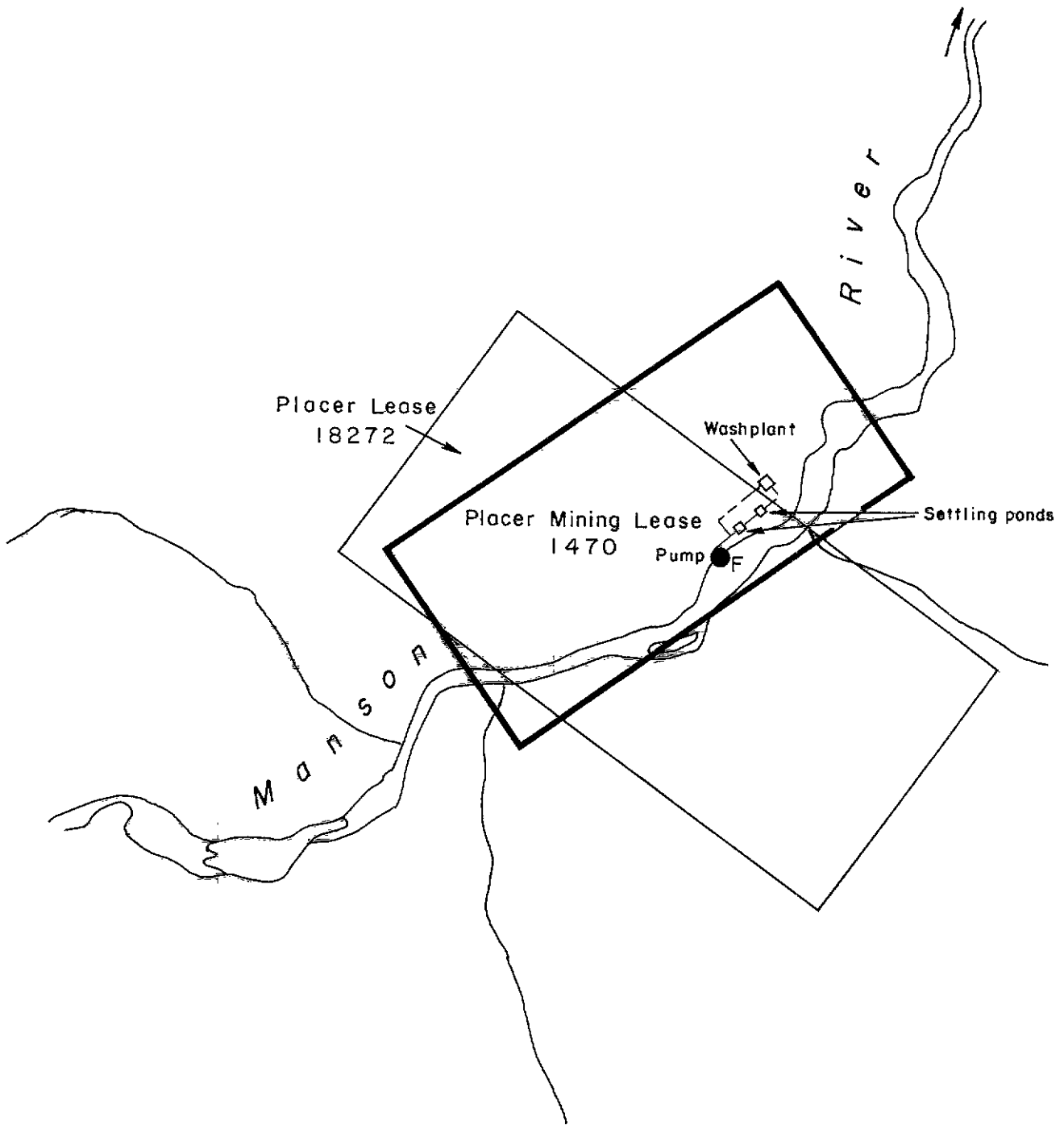
- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Manson River.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan, within Placer Mining Lease 1470, Omineca Mining District.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 25th May, 1993.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Mining (Placer).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 0.5 c.f.s. The water shall be used for replenishment of a closed re-circulatory system.
- (f) Water may be used throughout the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Placer Mining Lease 1470, Omineca Mining District.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are pump, pipes, ditches, washplant and settling ponds, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) Settling pond dams shall be protected from erosion and they shall be filled in and/or breached when abandoned.
