
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- (a) The source on which the rights are granted is Rushton Creek and the reservoir is Rushton Lake.
- (b) The points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 28th September, 1994.
- (d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage and irrigation.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored and diverted is 56 acre feet per annum.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted into storage is 1st October to 15th June and used for irrigation purpose is 1st April to 30th September.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the Southeast ¼, Section 8; Southwest ¼, Section 9; Northwest ¼, Section 16; Southwest ¼ Section 21, Township 22, Range 17, West of the 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District of which 22.4 acres may be irrigated.
- (h) The authorized works are diversion structures, ditches and dam which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to the 31st day of December 2005. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) This licence is issued pursuant to the provisions of the Water Act to ensure compliance with that statute, which makes it an offence to divert or use water from a stream in British Columbia without proper authorization. It is the responsibility of the licensee to ensure that all activities conducted under this authorization are carried out with regard to the rights of third parties, and comply with other applicable legislation that may be in force.
- (k) Construction or reconstruction of the dam authorized under clause (h) hereof shall not begin until plans of same have been submitted to and have been approved by an Engineer under the Water Act.
