




THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA—WATER ACT

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Joseph L. Leblanc and Donna D. Leblanc, in co-operation with Ducks Unlimited (Canada), 1290 South Mackenzie Avenue, Williams Lake, BC, V2G 3Y1, are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Leblanc Marsh.
- (b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached sketch.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 9, 1995.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (stockwatering).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 5,000 gallons per day.
- (f) The period of the year during which water may be used is the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the Southwest 1/4 and the Southeast 1/4 of District Lot 8277, Cariboo District.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are diversion structures, ditches and dugouts, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached sketch.
- (i) The works shall be constructed to allow for the watering of stock outside the wetted perimeter of Leblanc Marsh.
- (j) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water beneficially used prior to December 31, 1998. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make a regular beneficial use of water in the manner authorized herein.
