

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The source on which the rights are granted is Samaha Spring.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 27th May, 1999.
- (d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are industrial (residential lawn and garden watering) and domestic.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (residential lawn and garden watering) purpose is 1.5 acre feet per annum and for domestic purpose is 500 gallons per day.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for industrial (residential lawn and garden watering) purpose is 1st April to 30th September and for domestic purpose is the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of Legal Subdivision 6, Section 26, Township 17, Range 25, West of the Sixth Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, lying right of Twaal Creek.
- (h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe, tank and sprinkler system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works have been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) This licence is issued pursuant to the provisions of the Water Act to ensure compliance with that statute, which makes it an offence to divert or use water from a stream in British Columbia without proper authorization. It is the responsibility of the licensee to ensure that all activities conducted under this authorization are carried out with regard to the rights of third parties, and comply with other applicable legislation that may be in force.
- (k) The domestic purpose authorized by this licence is for use in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
