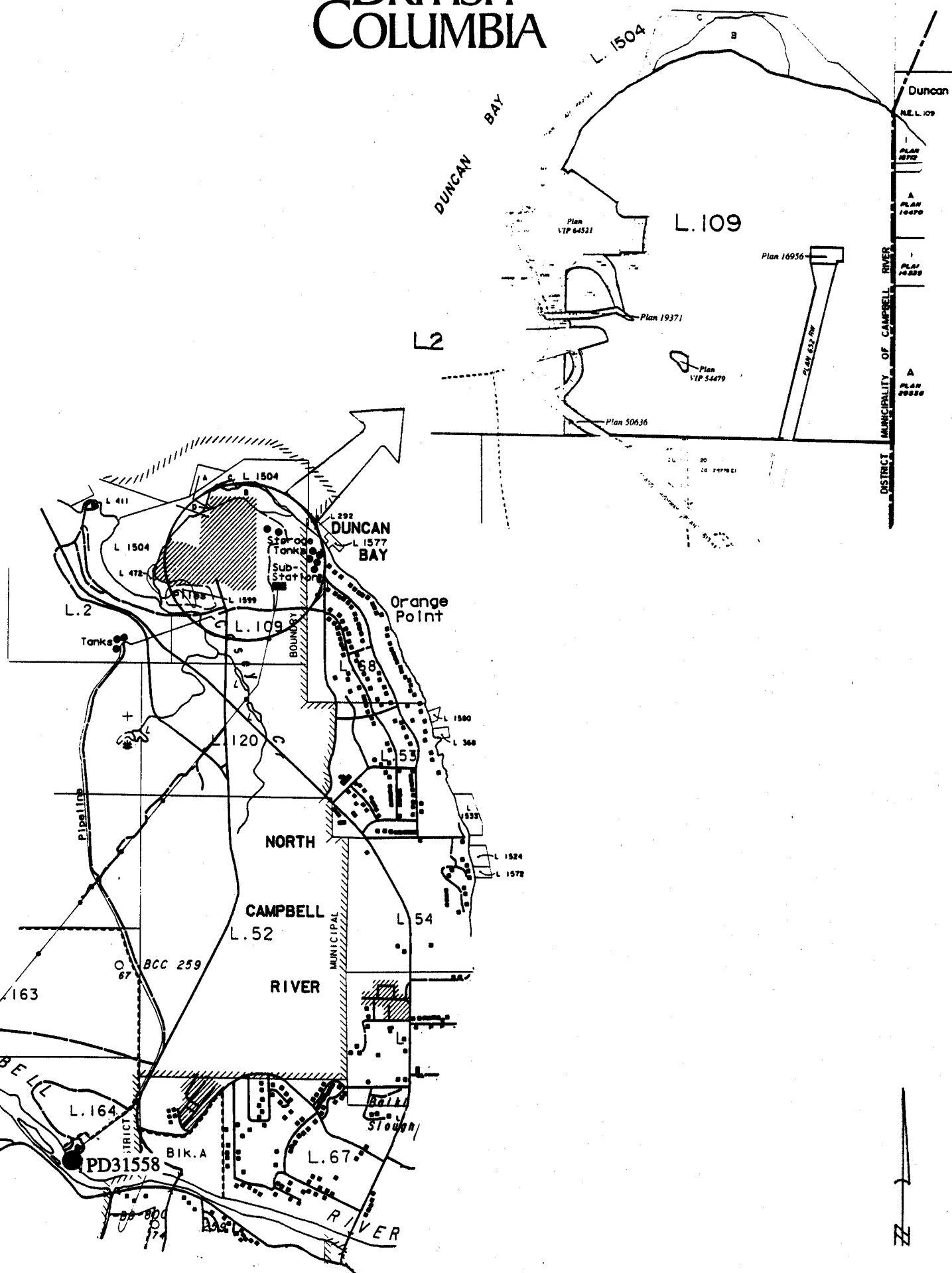


CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Campbell River.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 14th July, 1965.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (pulp and paper mill)
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 35.0 cubic feet per second.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is District Lot 109, Sayward District, except Parcel A (DD 285472-I) and those parts within Plans 1373-R, 16956, 19371, 50636, VIP54479 and VIP64521.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are diversion structure, pump, pipe, and tanks, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The intake shall be adequately screened to prevent debris and fish from entering the works.
- (j) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make a regular, beneficial use of water in the manner authorized herein.
- (l) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 30908, under Section 19 of the Water Act 1996, RS Chap 483.
