
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The source on which the rights are granted is Bellevue Creek.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 1st May, 2000.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is conservation.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 100 acre feet per annum.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st May to 15th June.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is South ½, District Lot 579, Similkameen Division Yale District and Lot B, Section 20, Township 29, Similkameen Division Yale District, Plan KAP44335.
- (h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe and pond (Jack Smith Lake) which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) This licence is issued pursuant to the provisions of the Water Act to ensure compliance with that statute, which makes it an offence to divert or use water from a stream in British Columbia without proper authorization. It is the responsibility of the licensee to ensure that all activities conducted under this authorization are carried out with regard to the rights of third parties, and comply with other applicable legislation that may be in force.
- (k) Works shall be installed to metre and record the rate of flow and quantity of water diverted from Bellevue Creek under this licence.
- (l) The diversion of water from Bellevue Creek shall cease when Jack Smith Lake has reached full capacity.
- (m) The diversion of water authorized under this licence shall not reduce the flow in Bellevue Creek, immediately downstream of the point of diversion, below 2 cubic feet per second.



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
