
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- (a) The source on which the rights are granted is Cache Creek.
- (b) The points of the measuring weir and diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 10th January 1866.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 393.6 acre feet per annum.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st April to 30th September.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of District Lot 1, Group 2, Kamloops (formerly Lytton) Division Yale District, lying south of the Trans-Canada Highway (Plan H-684), of which 131.2 acres may be irrigated.
- (h) The authorized works are measuring weir, diversion structure, ditch, control box, pump, pipe and sprinkler system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 39045, in part.
