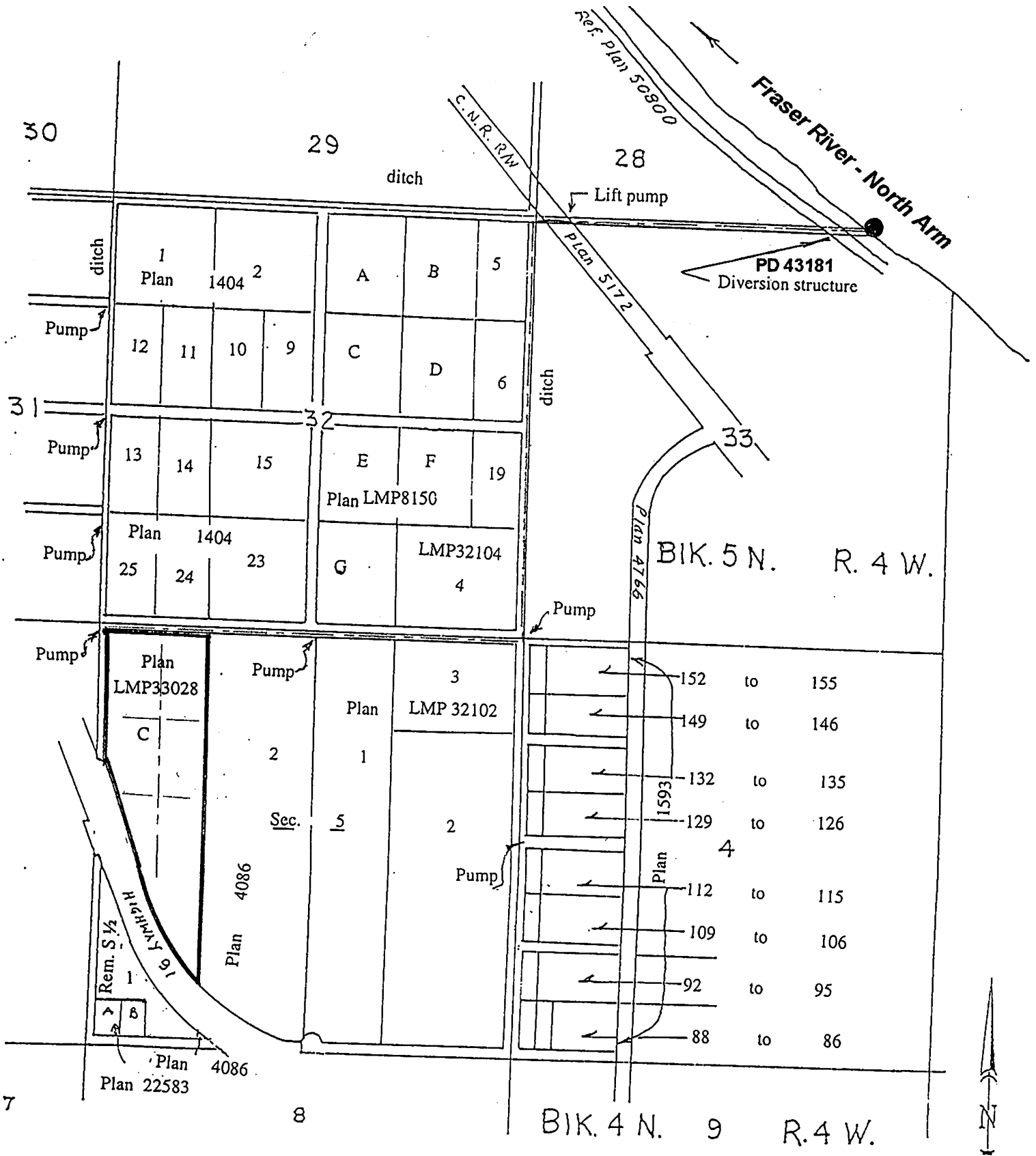

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:


- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is **Fraser River North Arm**.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is **29<sup>th</sup> March 1984**.
- (d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are **irrigation, industrial (frost protection) and industrial (flood harvesting & pest control by flooding)**.
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is **38.25 acre feet per annum for irrigation purpose; 102.0 acre feet per annum for industrial (frost protection) purpose; and 38.25 acre feet per annum for industrial (flood harvesting & pest control by flooding) purpose**.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is **June 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31st for irrigation purpose, March 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup> and September 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30th for industrial (frost protection) purpose, and June 15<sup>th</sup> to November 30th for industrial (flood harvesting & pest control by flooding) purpose**.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is **Lot C of Section 5, Block 4 North, Range 4 West, New Westminster District, Plan LMP33028, of which 25.5 acres may be irrigated**.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are **diversion structure, ditch, pumps, dugout, pipe and sprinkler system** which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make a regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an order in writing of the Engineer for the New Westminster Water District in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream for the preservation of fish life.
