



CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized as follows:

- (a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Hawk Creek.
- (b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- (c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 8th April, 1970.
- (d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (logging camp).
- (e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 100,014 litres (22,000 gallons) per day.
- (f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- (g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1, Block 75, Cowichan Lake District and District Lot 887, Renfrew District, Plan 40245.
- (h) The works authorized to be constructed are diversion structure, tank and pipe, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- (j) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make a regular, beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- (k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence No. 60614, under Section 18, Water Act, RSBC 1996, Chapter 483.
