Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

Encana Corporation, PO Box 2850, 150-9th Avenue S.W., Calgary AB, T2P 2S5 are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Wasp Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is January 25, 2007.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (mining equipment).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and used is 1,000 cubic metres (220,000 gallons) per day and a maximum of 8,500 cubic metres (1,870,000 gallons) per year.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be used is 1st November to 30th April.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Oil & Gas activities within that parcel or tract of unsurveyed Crown land in the vicinity of Wasp Lake (within Unit 96, Block L, 93-P-7) held under Petroleum & Natural Gas lease numbers: 50560, 50562, 51065, 53474, 53831, 54411, 54412, 54413, 54605, 54606, 54607, 54608, 54610, 54612, 54616, 54622, 54623, 54624, 54625, 55515, 56978, 57270, 57474, 57525, 57525, 57971 and 58124.
- h) The works authorized to be constructed are pump, pipe, screened intake and tank truck, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer or Regional Water Manager under the Water Act.
- j) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- k) The licensee shall keep records on actual water use as directed by an Engineer or Regional Water Manager under the Water Act and have all records available.
- l) The licence will only be valid for a period of five years from the date of issue. Prior to the termination date, you may apply to the Comptroller of Water Rights or the Regional Water Manager in accordance with the provisions of the Water Act to amend this licence to extend its term. Any application to extend the term should be filed sufficiently in advance of the termination date to provide adequate time for Water Stewardship Division staff to review the file and impacts on the environment.
- m) The rights under the licence are subject to a water reserve established by Order by Council No. 2860 dated September 24, 1976.
