

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Hunt Creek and the reservoir is Hunt Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 5, 2008.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are enterprise and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 441 cubic metres (97,006.44 gallons) per day. The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and held in storage is 116,000 cubic metres (91.04 acre feet).
- f) The period of the year during which water may be used to fill the reservoir is the whole year and the stored water may be used during the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that land within District Lot 1150, 1151 and Block A, District Lot 1665 all of Sayward District.
- h) The works authorized to be constructed are dam, diversion structure and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being beneficially used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the *Water Act* and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- k) Final construction drawings for any dam reconstruction along with Operation, Maintenance and Surveillance Manual and Emergency Preparedness Plan must be submitted to the Dam Safety Officer during the first year of operation.
- l) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be regulated at any time by an Order of an Engineer under the *Water Act*, in order to maintain flow in the stream for the preservation of aquatic life. Regulation includes allowing, commencing, stopping, limiting, opening, shutting and prohibiting the diversion of water.

- m) The licensee shall install works to meter and record the rate of flow and quantity of water delivered under this licence.
