

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The licencee is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Stokke Creek.

- b) The point of diversion PD 82124 is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 16, 2008.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is conservation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 0.5 cubic metres per second (17.66 cubic feet per second).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is Whole Year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the conservation project of the licensee within Blocks A and D of District Lot 6862, held under Lands File 2408406 and Block C of District Lot 6862, held under Lands File 2408237, together with unsurveyed foreshore or land covered by water being part of the bed of Stokke Creek, all within Group 1, New Westminster District.
- h) The authorized works are intake, pipe, ponds, diversion channel which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the Water Act, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
