CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of Mining Lease No. 631503 to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Rainbow Creek, Williston Lake, Philip Lake and Robinson Lake.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 8, 2010.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (dust control).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (dust control) from Rainbow Creek is 46 cubic metres per day. The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted from each of the following sources is 23 cubic metres per day: Williston Lake, Philip Lake and Robinson Lake.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant to is outlined in the Road Use Permit issued by Ministry of Forests and Range (Mackenzie) covered by File No. 11360-20.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe and tank truck which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2014. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted per day from Rainbow Creek is not to exceed 10 percent of current flow and diversion is not permitted where discharge is less than 55 litres per second.
- k) No diversion is permitted where stream (wetted) depth is less than 0.30 metres (12 inches) at the withdrawal location.
- l) No water will be diverted or removed from any beaver pond.
- m) This licence does not authorize any instream work.
- n) The points of diversion are located at existing stream crossing structures and/or existing access points.

- o) This Approval does not authorize entry onto private or crown land.
- p) The rights granted under this licence are subject to a water reserve established by Order in Council No 2673, dated November 27, 1953.
- q) This licence will only be valid for the same period as Mining Lease No. 631503.
