CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Cluculz Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 15th December 2009.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and used under this licence is 0.125 m³/s (4.414333 ft³/s).
- f) Water may be diverted and used throughout the whole year while maintaining a minimum flow of 20% of the Mean Annual Discharge (MAD) directly below the intake. As of the date of issuance of this licence, the MAD has been determined to be 3.750 m³/s (132.43 ft³/s) and therefore the minimum flow shall be 0.750 m³/s (26.486 ft³/s). The requirement for minimum flow may be subject to change in the event that additional flow data or environmental impacts warrant a review of these flows.
- g) The land upon which water is to be used is the Fractional North 1/2 of District Lot 1178, Cariboo District except Plan A2130 on which a powerhouse is situated.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, surge tank, penstock, powerhouse, tailrace which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to 31st December 2013. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to one dwelling on the Fractional North 1/2 of District Lot 1178 Cariboo District except Plan A2130 as shown on the attached plan.
- k) Prior to the commencement of any construction authorized under clause (h) of this licence, the licensee must:
 1. Submit to the satisfaction of the Regional Water Manager, the following:
 - a. plans that show the general arrangement of works to be constructed,
 - b. criteria for the design and operation of these works to be constructed,
 - c. a schedule for the construction of these works,
 - d. final as-built drawings within one year of commissioning.



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- l) The term of this licence is 40 years from the date of issuance of this licence.
