



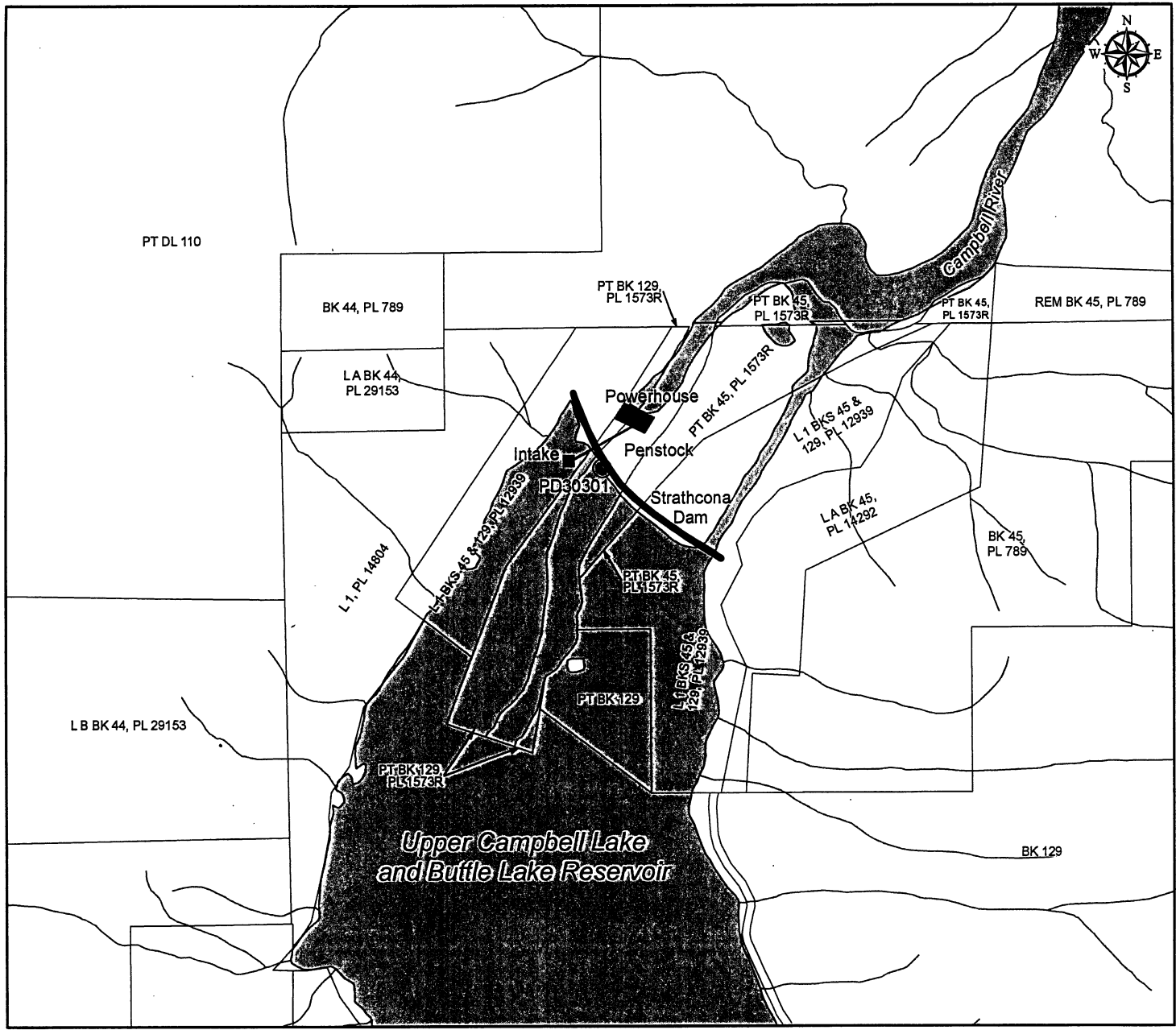

WATER ACT

FINAL WATER LICENCE

British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Campbell River.
- b) The point of diversion is PD30301, located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is December 19, 1967.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power, which is to be generated at Strathcona Generating Station.
- e) The maximum rate at which water may be diverted and used under this licence is 98.68 cubic metres per second.
- f) The water may be diverted and used throughout the whole year.
- g) This licence is appurtenant to the undertaking of British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority to generate power at the Strathcona Generating Station situated on Blocks 45 and 129, Comox District.
- h) The authorized works are the Strathcona Dam, intake, penstock and powerhouse as shown on the attached plan, and ancillary works associated with the operation of the dam and powerhouse.
- i) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 33093 and under section 18 (1) (i).
