

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of Mineral Lease 353594 and Mineral Claim 855204 to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Streamnine Creek, Mosquito Creek and Thirty-metre Creek.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 29, 2011
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is land improvement.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and used under this licence is the total flow.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the entire year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the mining project of the licensee within Mineral Lease 353594 and Mineral Claim 855204, Omineca Mining Division.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structures, diversion channel, pipe, energy dissipator plunge pool and re-diversion structure which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2014. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be constructed, maintained and operated in a manner that minimizes erosion and to the satisfaction of the Regional Water Manager.
- Ensure the works to be constructed under clause (h) are designed to accomodate the 1:200 year design flood event and upon completion of these works, as-built drawings for these works signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer registered in the Province of British Columbia must be submitted to the Regional Water Manager.
- m) Within three months of constructing the works, an Operation, Maintenance and Surveillance Plan must be submitted to the Regional Water Manager.

n) When the mining operation is completed, the licensee shall re-establish drainage in the area, to the satisfaction of the Regional Water Manager.
