## *Water Act*


### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Stumplake Creek.
- b) The points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 11th August, 1883.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 266,184.98 cubic metres per annum (215.8 acre-feet per annum) and the maximum rate at which water is diverted from Stump Lake at anytime shall not exceed the flow at PD54462 on Stumplake Creek.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st April to 30th September.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of Lot 2 within District Lot 229 Kamloops Division Yale District Plan KAP76218 lying east and southeast of Highway No. 5A except Old Kamloops Road and Fraser Road of which 34.92 hectares (86.3 acres) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are flow measuring devices, screened intake, pump, pipe and sprinkler system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction,

maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The licensee shall install flow measuring devices to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act at point of diversion PD54462 on Stumplake Creek and point of re-diversion PD54469 on Stump Lake.
- l) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Act.
- m) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence 14526.
