## *Water Act*

### **CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE**

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Halcyon Hot Springs.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is August 5, 1898.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Industrial (mineral trading - bottling).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 227.3 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1, District Lot 2451, Kootenay District, Plan NEP84154.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structures, division tank, pipe and filling station which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued pursuant to the provisions of the Water Act to ensure compliance with that statute, which makes it an offence to divert or use water from a stream in British Columbia without proper authorization. It is the responsibility of the licensee to ensure that all activities conducted under this authorization are carried out with regard to the rights of third parties, and comply with other applicable legislation that may be in force.

k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 120264, in part.
