## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Knucwentwecw Development Corporation is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Thompson River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 16th February, 2010.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 1,751,457.89 cubic metres per annum (1419.93 acre-feet per annum).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st April to 30th September.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of District Lot 2457 Skeetchestn Indian Reserve No. 1 lying south and south west of the Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 (Plan 4428) and lying north and north east of Canadian National Railway (Plans 1910 and 1910A) of which 191.54 hectares (473.31 acres) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pump, pipe and sprinkler system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction,

maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The licensee shall install a flow measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- l) The licensee shall retain flow meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the Water Act.
- m) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the Water Act, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream for the preservation of fish and other aquatic life.
