CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert, store, and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Ten Ten Creek and storage is in a reservoir.
- b) The point of diversion and storage reservoir are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 29, 1968.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are irrigation and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be held in storage is 24,700 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation is 49,400 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted into and held in storage is the whole year and the period of the year during which water may be used for irrigation is the 1st of April to the 30th of September.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 2, Section 7 and 8, Range 1 West, North Saanich District, Plan 25609, of which 16.2 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are dam, reservoirs, spillway, pump, pipe and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licences C034309 and C034310.
