

Province of British Columbia Water Act

FINAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and store water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Dropping Water Creek and Adams Spring and storage is in Reservoir A, Reservoir B and Tullee Lake.
- b) The points of diversion and storage are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 10th August, 1950.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and stored is 74008.91 cubic metres per annum (60 acre-feet per annum).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted and stored is 1st October to 15th June.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is as set out in Final Water Licence 129994 or any licence issued in substitution thereof.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structures, ditches and dams which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

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- k) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence 14541.
