## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Sumas River.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 7, 1953.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for irrigation purpose is 6,722.476 cubic metres (5.45 acre feet) per annum.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 11, Section 6, Township 19, New Westminster District, Plan 4115 of which 6.42 acres may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are pipe and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to October 2015. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall submit to the Regional Water Manager, a Beneficial Use Declaration and a drawing prepared to the water licence application drawing standards showing the point of diversion, area of beneficial use, all associated works, and the legal boundaries of the appurtenant land, on or before the 1st day of October 2015.
- k) The intake must be screened to prevent the entry of aquatic wildlife. For further guidance, refer to the Fisheries and Oceans Canada Freshwater Intake End-of-Pipe Fish Screen Guideline at <http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/Library/223669.pdf>
