Water Act


CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Ralph Spring.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 15th May, 1956.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are industrial (stock watering) and residential (lawn/garden watering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted industrial (stock watering) is 1.81844 cubic metres (400 gallons) per day and the maximum quantity which may be used for residential (lawn/garden watering) is 7.274 cubic metres (1600 gallons) per day not to exceed 873.305 cubic metres (0.708 acre feet) annually
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for industrial (stock watering) is the Whole year and for residential (lawn/garden watering) is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1 Sections 16 and 17 Township 21 Range 17 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District amended Plan 32654 and that part of Lot 35 lying to the east of Parcel 40 shown on Plan H68 Section 17 Township 21 Range 17 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Plan 529 except Plans 32653, 42170 and 42774.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, collection box, pipe and troughs which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream.

The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The industrial stock watering purpose authorized by this licence is for use outside the wetted perimeter of the source in a trough located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 115826.
