

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Evans Brook.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is July 3, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for power (residential) purpose is 0.002 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is 1st November to 31st March. The water may be diverted for a maximum of five (5) hours per day.
- g) The land upon which water is to be used is Lot 3, Section 11, Lasqueti Island, Nanaimo District, Plan 42740 on which a powerhouse is situated, and the land to which the licence is appurtenant is said land.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe, tank, and powerhouse which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The term of this licence is 40 years from the date of issuance of this licence.
- k) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to two dwellings on Lot 3, Section 11, Lasqueti Island, Nanaimo District, Plan 42740 as shown on the attached plan.

1) The rights granted under this licence may not be exercised at the same time as the rights granted under Conditional Water Licence C130824.
