CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

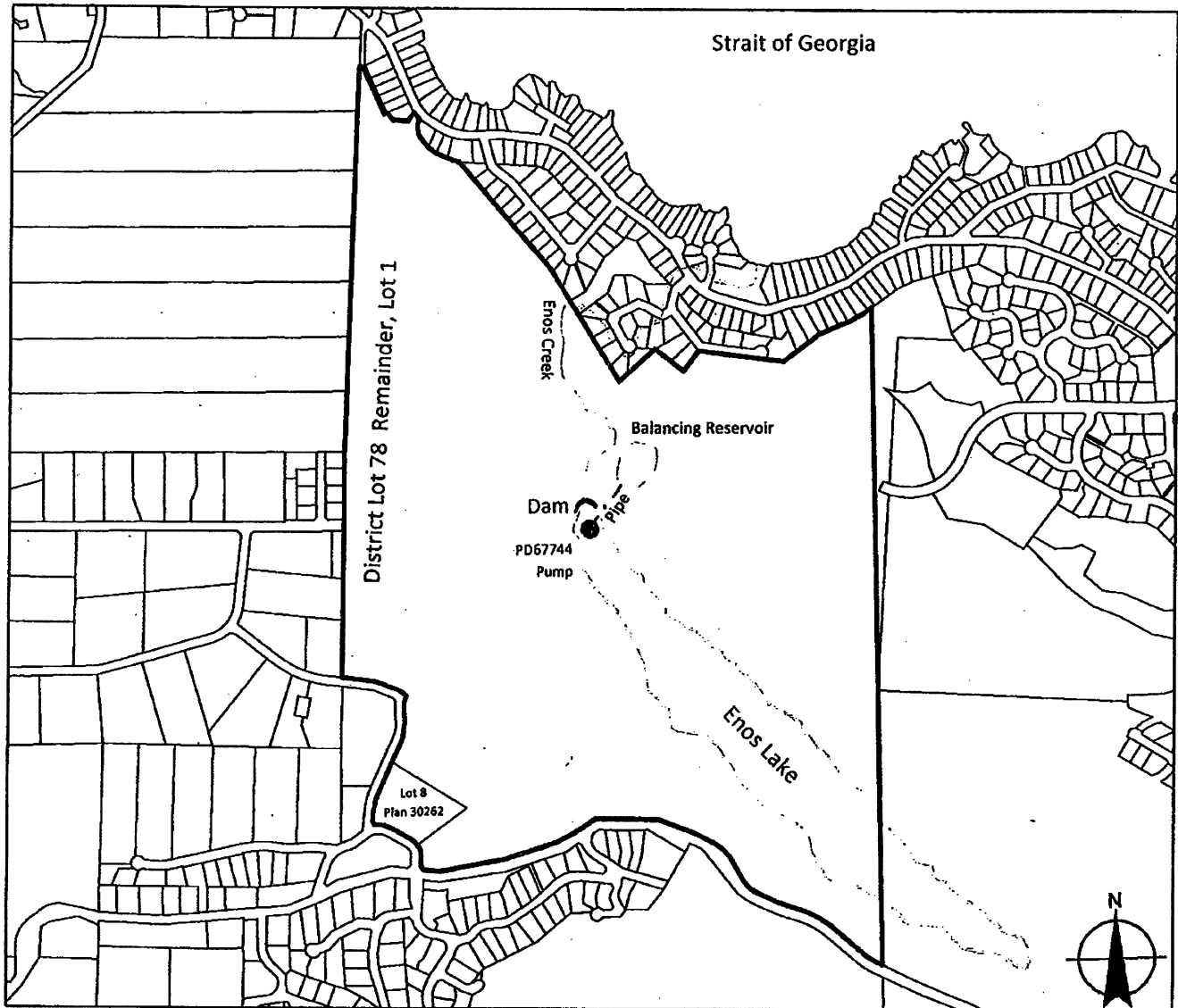
The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Enos Lake and storage is in Enos Lake.
- b) The storage site and point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is November 23, 1992.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage and industrial (golf course irrigation).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted into storage is 248,000 cubic metres per year, and the maximum quantity of water which may be used for industrial (golf course irrigation) purpose is 185,000 cubic metres per year, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted into storage is November 01 to March 31, and the water may be held in storage throughout the year. The period of the year that the water may be used for industrial (golf course irrigation) purpose is April 01 to September 30, except as stated in clause (k) herein, and subject to the water being available from storage.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that portion of Lot 1, District Lots 30 and 78, Nanoose District, Plan 26219, except those parts in plans 28246, 29574, 30072, 30262, 34675, 36514, 48548 and VIP53001, lying north of Fairwinds Drive, and Lot 8, District Lot 78, Plan 30262; all within Nanoose District.
- h) The authorized works are dam, pump, pipe, balancing reservoir and irrigation system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.

- j) A flow measuring device acceptable to the Engineer under the *Water Act*, shall be incorporated into the works at the source. Lake levels shall be recorded and all readings shall be submitted to the Regional Water Manager on the last day of each month.
- k) If the level of the water in Enos Lake falls to 50 millimetres below full supply during the period of April 01 to July 14, use of water for industrial (golf course irrigation) shall cease.
- l) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time, by an order in writing from an engineer under the *Water Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
- m) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the *Water Act* and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- n) The intake shall be adequately screened to prevent debris and fish from entering the works.
- o) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C106552.
