





Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Enns Spring and Battani Creek.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is February 1, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 2.27305 cubic meters (500 gallons) a day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 6, Block 7, District Lot 1815, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 3149.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe and tank which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- k) The primary source for water supply for this licence is Enns Spring. Water from Battani Creek is the secondary source of water supply for this licence during the dry season. The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted under this licence is that quantity which together from both Enns Spring and Battani Creek will provide 2.27305 cubic meters (500 gallons) a day.
