Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Peterson Creek.
- b) The point{s} of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is October 6, 1877.
- d) The purpose[s] for which this licence is issued are Irrigation and Industrial (stock watering).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for Irrigation is 255,824.1668 cubic metres (207.4 acre feet) per annum and the maximum quantity which may be used for Industrial (stock watering) is 2.27305 cubic metres (500 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for Irrigation is April 1 to September 30 and for Industrial (stock watering) is the Whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot A District Lot 453 and of Section 30 Township 19 Range 17 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Plan 18669 except Plans KAP51391 and KAP60271 of which 28.004 hectares (69.2 acres) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, intake, pipe, pump, sprinklers and trough which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must

make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The industrial stockwatering purpose authorized by this licence is for use outside the wetted perimeter of the source in a trough located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- l) This licence is supplementary to Conditional Water Licence 130930, Anderson Creek and the maximum quantity of water which may be diverted under this licence is the quantity which together with the quantity available under Conditional Water Licence 130930, shall not exceed 255,824.1668 cubic metres (207.4 acre feet) per annum.
- m) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence 45464.
