

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Ministry of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations, as represented by Fish and Wildlife Allocation Section, is hereby authorized to divert and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Anderson Creek and storage is in a reservoir, Edith Lake.
- b) The storage site and the points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 9th November, 1883.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted to fill the reservoir is 194026.7186 cubic metres (157.3 acre feet) per annum and the maximum quantity of water which may be used is 194026.7186 (157.3 acre feet) per annum, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The reservoir may be filled from October 1 to June 1 and the water released from storage at any time of the year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the conservation project of the licensee within Lot 1 Section 36 Township 18 range 18 West of the 6th Meridian Kamloops Division Yale District Plan KAP90210.
- h) The authorized works are dam and ditch which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other

applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- 1) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence 19452, in part.
