## *Water Act*


### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Stumplake Creek and storage is in Palmer Meadows Lake.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 30, 1960.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are irrigation and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted and stored is 55,506.6828 cubic metres (45 acre feet) per year.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted into storage is October 1 to June 15 and the stored water may be used for irrigation during April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is Lot A, Section 33 and 34, Township 16, Range 17, West of the 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, Plan KAP63680, of which 7.28434 hectares (18 acres) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are a dam, diversion structure, ditch, pump, pipe and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the *Water Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance,

use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C122220
