

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert, use, and store water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Carlyle, Carman and Carmona Springs and storage is in a reservoir.
- b) The storage site and the points of diversion and re-diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 10th August, 1977.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are industrial (stockwatering), irrigation and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (stockwatering) purpose is 4.54 cubic metres (1000 gallons) per day, the maximum quantity which may be used for irrigation purpose is 93,000 cubic metres (75 acre feet) per annum and the maximum quantity which may be used for storage purpose is 37,000 cubic metres (30 acre feet) per annum, all on the East 1/2 of the North West 1/4 Section 11, Township 7, ODYD.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for industrial (stockwatering) purpose is the whole year, for irrigation purpose is 1st April to 30th September and for storage purpose is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the East 1/2 of the North West 1/4 Section 11, Township 7, Osoyoos Division Yale District of which 20.24 hectares (50 acres) may be irrigated and industrial (stockwatering) may occur.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structures, storage reservoir, pump, pipe, ditches, sprinklers and a trough which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.

- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 119122.
