

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Scott-Goldie Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 8, 2013.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are domestic/fire protection and swimming pool use.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic/fire protection use is 2.500 cubic meters (549.922 gallons) per day and for swimming pool use is 0.113652 cubic meters (25 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for domestic/fire protection purpose is the whole year and for swimming pool purpose is from April 1st to October 1st.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 21, Block 3, District Lot 1417, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan VAP5679.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe, two tanks and a fire protection system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall submit to the Regional Water Manager, a Beneficial Use Declaration and a drawing prepared to the water licence application drawing standards showing the point of diversion, area of beneficial use, all associated works, and the legal boundaries of the appurtenant land, on or before the 31st day of December, 2016.
- k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic/fire protection purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
