

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Grant Lake Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 23, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power-residential.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for power-residential purpose is 0.026 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which water is to be used is Lot 1, District Lot 40, Malahat District, Plan 49720 on which a powerhouse is situated, and the land to which the licence is appurtenant is said land.
- h) The authorized works are intake, penstock, powerhouse, tailrace and transmission line which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to three (3) dwellings on Lot 1, District Lot 40, Malahat District, Plan 49720 as shown on the attached plan.
- k) The term of this licence is forty (40) years from the date of issuance of this licence.
