## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of a lease held under Lands file 3410324 to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Anesty creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 5th September, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is enterprise.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for enterprise purpose is 10 cubic metres (2200 gallons) per day for the period of November 15<sup>th</sup> until April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- f) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for enterprise purpose is 0.45 cubic metres (100 gallons) per day for the period of April 16<sup>th</sup> until November 14<sup>th</sup>.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is a Crown Lease under Lands File 3410324, District Lot 6437, Kamloops Division of Yale District and containing 4.87 hectares.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe and pump which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence terminates on 15th January, 2024 coincident with the expiry of the Crown Lease. Prior to the termination date, and if the Crown Lease term is being extended, the licensee may apply to the Regional Water Manager to amend this licence to extend its term.

- k) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.



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
