CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Marshall Creek and Hopkinson Creek.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 24, 2006.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is domestic.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for domestic purpose is 2.27 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 34, District Lot 1094, Sayward District, Plan 26578.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in 1 dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C124626.
