CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Marshall Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is March 24, 2006.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is power (residential).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for power (residential) purpose is 0.00037 cubic metres per second.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is October 15 to April 15.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 34 and Lot 39, District Lot 1094, Sayward District, Plan 26578.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe, power house and transmission line which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein. Confirmation of beneficial use must be confirmed by the licensee prior to December 31, 2017 or the licence will be susceptible to cancellation.
- j) The licence is issued for a term of forty (40) years from August 29, 2007, provided beneficial use is confirmed by December 31, 2017.
- k) The power generation pursuant to this licence may be supplied to 3 dwellings on Lot 34 and Lot 39, District Lot 1094, Sayward District, Plan 26578, as shown on the attached plan.
- l) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C124627.
