
CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Hutchison Lake and storage is in a reservoir, Hutchison Lake.
- b) The storage site and point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 21st September, 1979.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are irrigation and storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted to fill the reservoir is 24,669.60 cubic metres (20 acre feet) per annum and the maximum quantity of water which may be used is 24,669.60 cubic metres (20 acre feet) per annum, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be diverted into storage is October 1 to June 15, and the stored water may be used for irrigation during the period April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 1 District Lot 3863 Lillooet District Plan KAP58622 except Plan EPP15991 of which 4.047 hectares (10 acres) may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are dam, intake, pump, pipe and sprinklers which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other

applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- l) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence 124642.
