## *Water Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Twin Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is December 9, 1992.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (tourist resort).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for industrial (tourist resort) purpose is 38.6 cubic metres per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot C, District Lot 1677, Sayward District, Plan VIP81874.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pipe and distribution system, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence expires on December 31, 2017.
  1. Prior to the expiry date, the licensee may apply to the Comptroller of Water Rights or the Regional Water Manager in accordance with the provisions of the *Water Act* to amend this licence to extend its term.
  2. As part of this application the licensee must submit a Beneficial Use Declaration and a drawing prepared to the water licence application drawing standards showing the point of diversion, area of beneficial use, all associated works, and the legal boundaries of the appurtenant land.
- k) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C105888.
