CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of a Licence of Occupation under Crown Lands file 2408043 to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Culloden Creek.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is September 6, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is work camp.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for work camp purpose is 2 cubic meters (439.9 gallons) per day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that part of District Lot 7630, together with unsurveyed Crown foreshore or land covered by water being part of the bed of Jervis Inlet, all within Group 1, New Westminster District, held under Lands File 2408043.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipes and tank which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The licensee shall submit to the Regional Water Manager, a Beneficial Use Declaration and a drawing prepared to the water licence application drawing standards showing the point of diversion, area of beneficial use, all associated works, and the legal boundaries of the appurtenant land, on or before December 31, 2016.

- k) This licence authorizes the use of water for domestic purpose in one dwelling located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
