

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Menzies Creek and storage is in a pond located on Lot A, Except: Part Subdivided by Plan LMP45248, Section 2, Township 40, New Westminster District, Plan LMP2687.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 11, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Land Improvement.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored is that quantity required to maintain the level of the pond.
- f) Water may be stored and used throughout the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the land improvement project of the licensee within Lot 1, Section 2, Township 40, New Westminster District, Plan LMP45248.
- h) The authorized works are a pond and weir which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- k) Design plans for the works authorized by this licence must be prepared by a professional engineer registered in the Province of British Columbia and submitted to an Engineer under the Water Act.

l) The licensee shall install a staff gauge in the pond to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
