## *Water Sustainability Act*

### CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The Glenmore-Ellison Improvement District is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Okanagan Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is June 30, 2005.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Waterworks: Local Provider.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 1,630,000 cubic metres per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is the waterworks purpose of the licensee within the boundaries of the Glenmore-Ellison Improvement District.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, pump and pipe which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2019. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing under the *Water Sustainability Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in a stream for the preservation of fish or for maintaining the health of aquatic ecosystems.
- k) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be constructed to operate within a lake elevation of 340.41 to 343.09 metres (1116.8 to 1125.3 feet), Geodetic Survey of Canada datum.

- l) The licensee shall install a flow metering or other measuring device to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- m) The licensee shall retain flow measurement/meter records for inspection upon request by an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- n) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Sustainability Act*.
- o) This licence is issued under the *Water Sustainability Act* (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream or on an aquifer. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.
