

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of a lease held under Crown Lands file 2410717 to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Gondola Creek 2.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is January 31, 2012.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are commercial enterprise (industrial) and fire protection (industrial).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for commercial enterprise purpose is 13 cubic meters (2,860 gallons) a day and the maximum quantity which may be used for fire protection purposes is 528.8 cubic meters (116,300 gallons) a year.
 - This licence does not authorize the diversion of water for commercial enterprise use when the water flow of Gondola Creek 2 falls below 0.003 cubic meters per second (5% Mean Annual Discharge) for the preservation of downstream aquatic life.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used for commercial enterprise and fire protection is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is that parcel or tract of land in the vicinity of Stawamus Chief Provincial Park, held under Crown Lands File 2410717.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe, treatment facility, tank, pump and fire protection works which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2016. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This Licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence C127714.

- k) This licensee shall keep records on actual water use as directed by an Engineer under the Water Act and have all records available.
- 1) The works authorized under clause (h) hereof shall be maintained to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the Water Act.
- The licensee shall submit to the Regional Water Manager, a Beneficial Use Declaration and a drawing prepared to the water licence application drawing standards confirming the point of diversion, area of beneficial use and all associated works on or before December 31, 2016.

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
