CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owners of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Romyn Brook and storage is in Toebosch pond.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is April 8, 1991.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is industrial (fish culture).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 14,800 m³ (12 acre-feet) per year.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be diverted into Toebosch pond is October 1 to June 15 and during which water may be used for industrial (fish culture) is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 2, Section 11, Township 22, Range 11, West of the 6th Meridian, Kamloops Division Yale District, Plan EPP28463.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, ditch, pond and dam which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works has been completed and the water is being used. The licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in a manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full

compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) This Licence is issued in substitution of Water Licence C103437.
- l) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
