

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The holder of a Licence of Occupation SK904033 to which this licence is appurtenant is hereby authorized to divert, use and store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Crowberry Pond.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is May 31, 2013.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is Industrial (work camps).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for Industrial (work camps) is 112.3 m3/day.
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is all year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the mining project of the licensee within Licence of Occupation SK904033, Lands File 6408448.
- h) The authorized works are screened intake, pipe, pump, water treatment plant and storage tank, which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to July 1, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The diversion of water authorized under this licence may be restricted or prohibited at any time by an Order in writing of an Engineer under the *Water Act*, in order to maintain a minimum flow in the stream.
- k) Upon cessation of mining operations, the works associated with this licence shall be removed to the satisfaction of an Engineer under the *Water Act*.
