

## Province of British Columbia Water Act

## CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to store water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Alex Creek and storage is in reservoirs, Sams and Mains Lakes.
- b) The storage sites are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 3rd June, 1945.
- d) The purpose for which this licence is issued is storage.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be stored is 74008.80 cubic metres (60 acre feet) per annum. (61674.00 cubic metres (50 acre feet Sams Lake) and 12334.80 cubic metres (10 acre feet Mains Lake).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be stored is October 1 to June 15.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is as set out in Conditional Water Licence 131051.
- h) The authorized works are dams which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) This licence is issued under the Water Act (the Act). The exercise of rights under the licence is subject to the Act and its regulations, the terms and conditions of the licence, orders under the Act and the rights of licensees whose rights have precedence on the stream. The licensee must comply with all such requirements, as well as the provisions of all other applicable enactments. In exercising rights under the licence, the licensee must exercise reasonable care to avoid damaging land, works, trees or other property, and must make full compensation to the owners for damage or loss resulting from construction, maintenance, use, operation or failure of the works.

- k) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines.
- 1) This Licence is issued in substitution of Final Water Licence 14852.
