CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner(s) of the land to which this licence is appurtenant is/are hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:

- a) The stream on which the rights are granted is Babine Lake.
- b) The point of diversion is located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is December 13, 2013.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are Industrial (effluent dilution) and industrial (work camp).
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted for effluent dilution is 20, 500 cubic metres per year (m^3/year) and shall not exceed a maximum daily withdrawal of 230 cubic metres (m^3/day). The maximum quantity which may be used for work camp is 15 cubic metres per day (m^3/day).
- f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the mining project of the licensee within District Lot 7845, being Newman 11 Mineral Claim and District Lot 7846, being Newman 12 Mineral Claim, Range 5, Coast District.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, screened intake, pipe, pump house and distribution system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.

- j) The licensee shall retain flow records for inspection upon request by the Regional Water Manager or Engineer under the *Water Act*.
