

Province of British Columbia Water Act

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

The owner of the land to which this licence is appurtenant are hereby authorized to divert, store and use water as follows:

- a) The streams on which the rights are granted are Dewey Creek and Whittaker Creek and storage is in dugouts.
- b) The points of diversion are located as shown on the attached plan.
- c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is December 11, 2013.
- d) The purposes for which this licence is issued are storage and irrigation.
- e) The maximum quantity of water which may be held in storage is 14,000 cubic metres per year and the maximum quantity of stored water which may be diverted and used for irrigation purpose is 12,300 cubic metres per year, subject to the water being available from storage.
- f) The period of the year during which water may be held in storage is the whole year, with diversion into storage from November 1 to March 31, and the period of the year during which the stored water may be used for irrigation purpose is April 1 to September 30.
- g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is Lot 2, Section 5, Range 2, Cowichan District, Plan VIP89391 of which 4.04 hectares may be irrigated.
- h) The authorized works are diversion structure, dam, dugouts, pipe, pump and irrigation system which shall be located approximately as shown on the attached plan.
- i) The construction of the said works shall be completed and the water shall be beneficially used prior to December 31, 2017. Thereafter, the licensee shall continue to make regular beneficial use of the water in the manner authorized herein.
- j) The dam authorized under clause (h) is subject to the Dam Safety Regulations and shall be designed, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of a Dam Safety Officer under the Water Act and in accordance with the Canadian Dam Association Guidelines. No major work to the dam is be commenced until plans have been approved by the Dam Safety Officer.
